

Table Mazes Using Microsoft Word

Objective:

- *Students will be able to create a maze with a theme using Microsoft Word and using the features of the Table and Border ribbon.*
- *Students will be able to incorporate clip art and WordArt into their mazes.*

Directions:

1. Open a new Word document.
2. Save as “yourname _ Maze”.
3. Insert a table with 20 columns and 30 rows. (Use Insert Table).
4. Use WordArt to add a title above the maze.
5. Merge 4 cells for the start & 4 cells for the finish.
6. Insert a clip art picture into the start space & finish space.
 - a. Change Text Wrapping to “Tight”
 - b. Bring in Front of Text (Picture Tools)
 - c. Resize the picture to fit in the space.
7. Construct the path that goes from the start cell to the finish cell.
8. Construct additional paths to form dead ends.
9. Include your name and class hour in the page header.
10. Make sure the mazes are solvable.
11. Preview the mazes by using the Print Preview.
12. Final step is to save your Maze as a .pdf and upload it to Google Classroom

I will make copies of each maze so that other students can solve your mazes.
